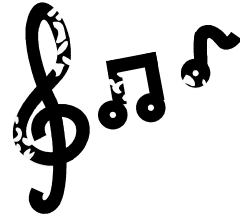


Application

1. Music –

Cheer (for older children) –

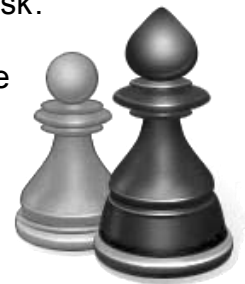
Parent starts: **What name can we call the LORD?**

2. Game – “20 Questions”

Play through several times using the following characters and objects. Allow older kids or parents to be the character/object, while the younger ones guess. Parents really help the young ones figure out what questions to ask. Once an object/character has been figured out, have all children tell what it has to do with the story. *Option:* If the 20 questions are too difficult, allow children to act some of these out to give clues of what to ask next.
